



Randy Osborne is the President of a political consulting firm, Victory 360 Inc. , as well as a lobbyist for Florida Eagle Forum, and is the Director of Education for Heartland Research, and Florida Eagle Forum. He is also the President of Stop Common Core Coalition, an organization made up of over 50 various organizations state-wide and

national. Randy has co-authored "Florida's Common Core Standards, Policy Analysis", "Our Children at Risk", and "The Dark Side of Gambling". He has organized state-wide events and rallies including, "Operation Education" with David Barton in Orlando FL., Mike Huckabee faith based initiative for Mitt Romney, and "Rally in Tally" events. Randy has appeared on PBS Round Table, twice on Glenn Beck's, The Blaze, and has a weekly radio appearance on a central Florida Fox affiliated network. He owns Florida Campaign School, which conducts day long seminars to teach candidates how to run for office.
